

New Trier Health Services Welcomes the Class of 2014

Important Dates

<i>May 15th</i>	<i>Physical exam and immunization record due for students attending summer school.</i>
<i>June 7th</i>	<i>Summer School begins. Students must have health records on file to start classes.</i>
<i>July 15th</i>	<i>Physical exam and immunization record due for school entry.</i>
<i>August 25th</i>	<i>1st day of student attendance. Health records must be on file to start classes.</i>

Illinois state law requires that all students provide documentation of a physical exam before the first day of school, including summer school. The exam must be within one year of school entry. Students who do not provide this documentation cannot be allowed into school. Athletic permits are required before students are allowed to try out for sports and must be renewed annually. This packet includes all the forms you need to submit for school entry and athletics. Forms are also available on New Trier's website, www.newtrier.k12.il.us. Go to Student Services/Health Services/Forms.

- The white physical form (Certificate of Child Health Exam) is two-sided and requires information from you and your physician. Please note any health conditions, disabilities, and medications taken on a regular basis.
- The blue emergency form is used to contact parents or their delegates in case of illness or injury.
- The pink medication form is available for administration of prescription and over-the-counter medications. **All** medications require physician **and** parent signatures. Generic Tylenol, Advil and Benadryl are available in Health Services. Students may carry labeled inhalers, EpiPens/Benadryl and Insulin with medication authorization on file.
- The Athletic Physical form requires signatures of physician, student and parent.
- Keep a copy of all records sent.
- Keep in mind that doctor's offices appointments for physicals fill quickly as the school year approaches.
