Dear Parents and Students of the Class of 2014:

The registration process for New Trier High School begins with a series of meetings, for **both parents and students**, in January called the **Academic Life** meetings to help you choose classes for next year, introduce you to our academic leadership personnel, and provide an opportunity for you and your student to ask questions regarding our program at the Northfield Campus. The meetings will begin with a general session at **7:00 p.m.** in the **Cornog Auditorium** at the **Northfield Campus**. The Cornog Auditorium is located in Building E at the Happ Road main entrance. The general session will be followed by an academic fair in the student cafeteria where specific questions regarding curriculum can be addressed with representatives from each department. The Academic Life program will be repeated on four different evenings; due to the limited seating in our auditorium, we highly encourage you to attend the session to which you have been assigned alphabetically by last name. Packets containing registration materials will be arranged in alphabetical order in the auditorium lobby. Please allow enough time to pick up your packet before entering the auditorium for the general session.
